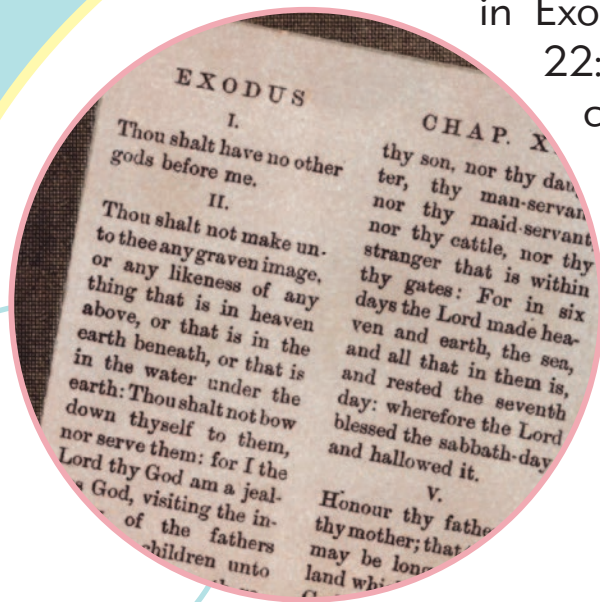
FAMILY OUTING

TOGETHER TIME!

In a family Bible, read the 10 Commandments in Exodus 20:1-17. Then read in Matthew 22:34-40 what Jesus said about the greatest commandments. Explain that reading the Bible is listening to God. Pray that you and your family can obey God's rules. Tell God which rules are difficult to keep. Thank God for His love and forgiveness when you break one of His rules. Ask God to help each family member learn to love Him and others more.
