**Family Devotions** 

Hopefully your preteen is beginning to develop a habit of personal devotions. But there are still plenty of times when your input is needed—and valued. Encourage your child to read the daily Scriptures. Read the verses yourself. Use the questions to help your preteen understand the verses and apply them to life. Discover and learn from God's Word—together!

- O SUNDAY—Read Luke 1:26-28. Gabriel told Mary, "The Lord is with you." Do you believe God is with you? How does that affect the way you live?
- OMONDAY—Read Luke 1:29-33. At first, Mary was troubled and wondered about the angel's words. Have you ever wondered what God's Word means to your life? What helps you understand His Word?
- TUESDAY—Read Luke 1:34-38. The angel reminded Mary that God's word never fails. When do you need to remember that God's Word never fails?
- O WEDNESDAY—Read Luke 1:46-50. Mary had an attitude of praise about the work God had given her to do. What is your attitude when you serve God?
- O THURSDAY—Read Luke 1:51-55. What "mighty deeds" has God done in your life or in the lives of people you know? How can we push aside pride and remain humble before God?

- OFRIDAY—Read 2 Timothy 2:20, 21. Paul wrote to Timothy that we are to be "made holy, useful to the Master and prepared to do good work." What can you do to be useful to God?
- O SATURDAY—Read Ephesians 6:7, 8. How are we to serve God? What does God promise to those who do good?
