Hopefully your preteen is beginning to develop a habit of personal devotions. But there are still plenty of times when your input is needed—and valued. Encourage your child to read the daily Scriptures. Read the verses yourself. Use the questions to help your preteen understand the verses and apply them to life. Discover and learn from God's Word—together!

- O SUNDAY—Read Micah 5:2. How was Micah's prophecy fulfilled? Thank God for always keeping His promises!
- OMONDAY—Read Luke 2:1-7 According to verse 7, in what was Jesus wrapped? Would you wrap a special present in this way? Do your friends know about God's wonderful gift?
- TUESDAY—Read Luke 2:8-14 Have you ever been told good news that surprised you? How did you react? How do you react when you hear God's great news about Jesus?
- WEDNESDAY—Read Luke 2:15-18. If you had been one of the shepherds, how would you have celebrated your find in Bethlehem? How are you celebrating Jesus in your life today?
- THURSDAY—Read Luke 2:19, 20. How did Mary respond to the shepherds' visit and all that was happening? When can you spend time quietly thinking about God's gifts to you?

- OFRIDAY—Read John 3:16, 17. What was God's main reason for sending Jesus to earth? How have you seen God's love in your life? How can we celebrate God's love today?
- O SATURDAY—Read 2 Corinthians 9:15. What do you say to someone who gives you a great gift? Have you thanked God for Jesus? Have you told Jesus why you appreciate Him?
